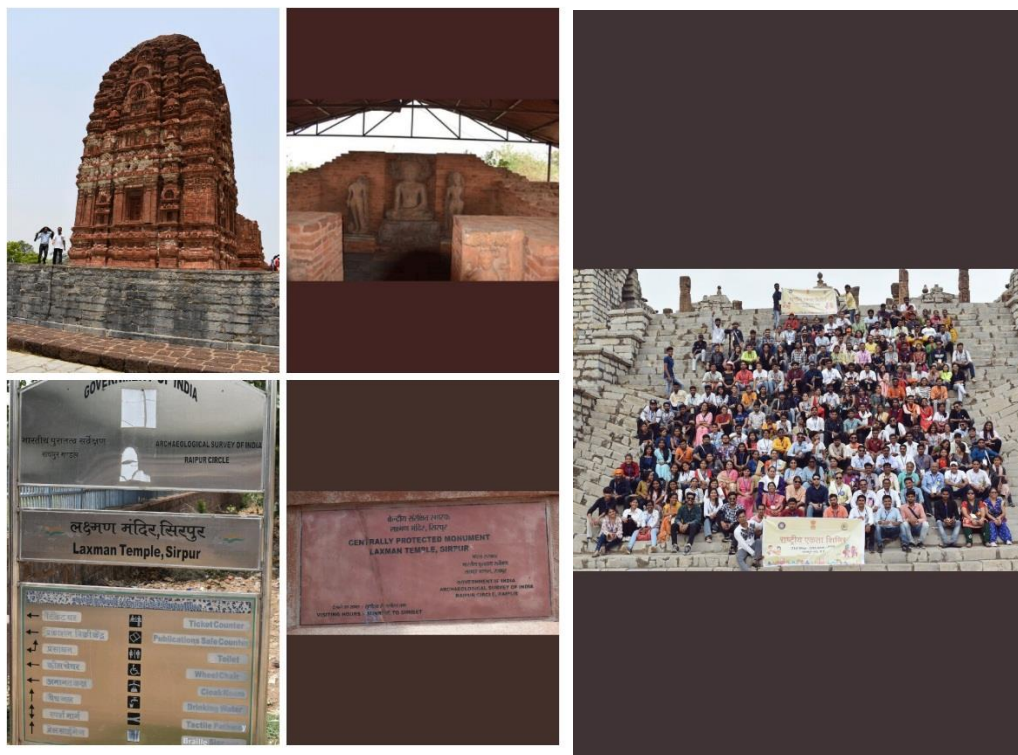
Day 5 (25.05.2022)

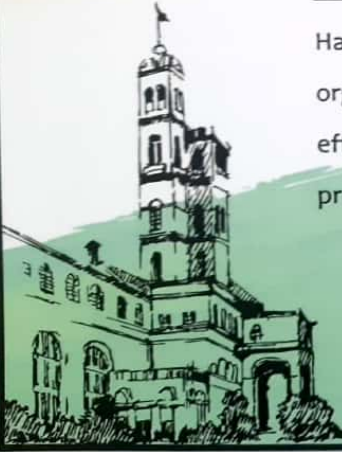
